Malaysian Invasion Mixed Martial Arts (MIMMA) seeks to discover and develop local MMA talents by being the platform for amateurs to compete and put their highly honed skills and countless hours of dedicated training to the test. Major cities throughout the country are targeted as centres for the tryouts to maximize the odds of potential MMA talents to be discovered. MIMMA is for all Malaysian citizens aged 18 years old and above are eligible to partake in the fighting championship which is divided into 7 different weight classes: Flyweight, Bantamweight, Featherweight, Lightweight, Welterweight, Middleweight and Heavyweight with additional 2 new Catchweight categories for Female and Foreign amateur fighters. Aspired to be the biggest amateur MMA fighting championship in Asia, MIMMA will also be featuring the largest prize money ever for a local tournament which is worth up to RM150,000 in total.
